

## **Warwick University, UK Master's Degree Programmes at Eastern Mediterranean University**

### **Introduction**

Warwick University is one of the UK's top-ranked universities, and the Warwick Manufacturing Group (WMG) has a reputation for outstanding quality in delivering programmes that provide a dynamic link between education and industry. Eastern Mediterranean University is now a Warwick University WMG Local Centre, meaning that Warwick WMG degrees can be taken on our EMU campus.

### **Which programmes are available at EMU?**

The following Warwick WMG programmes are currently offered at the EMU Centre:

- 1) MSc in Engineering Business Management
- 2) MSc in Supply Chain and Logistics Management

### **Who can apply?**

You will have completed an undergraduate degree in engineering, information technology, business or other scientific discipline. Other disciplines may also be considered if you have a proven adequate level of numeracy and / or relevant work experience.

You should have a minimum CGPA of 2.5 or second class honours degree.

### **Is there an English language requirement?**

Warwick University set an official IELTS entry threshold of 6.5, or equivalent.

EMU graduates are exempt from this requirement.

External applicants are expected to have a minimum of 6.0 on IELTS, and may be conditionally accepted onto the programme on condition that they are able to supply a 6.5 band score by the end of their programme.

Since:

- 1) The course demands a lot of writing
- 2) Modules are highly interactive and participants are expected to contribute actively

EMU provides a programme of language and study skills support for all WMG students, which all WMG students are required to attend. There is no additional charge for this course.

### **How long does the course take to complete?**

The full programme comprises nine modules and a project, and it is possible to complete it in **one year**.

### **How is the course delivered?**

Each module comprises one week of intensive full-day instruction to be followed by a 4000-6000 word assignment.

The project which you start work on at the beginning of the course is approximately 20,000 words.

7 modules are delivered by WMG staff who will come to EMU for the intensive week. 2 modules are delivered by specialists at EMU. You will also have a project and course supervisor at EMU.

### **What are the modules?**

Both courses will have the same modules; the major difference between the two courses will be in the project area selected. The modules for the 2011-2012 academic year are as follows:

#### **2011**

Oct 24-28: Logistics and Operations Management

Nov 21-25: Supply Chain and Logistics Management

#### **2012**

Jan 9-13: Product Design and Development Management

Feb 6-10: Quality Management and Techniques

Mar 5-9: Procurement and Inventory Management

Apr 2-6: Operations Strategy for Industry

May 7-11: Financial Analysis and Controls Systems

Jun 11- 15: Project Planning Control and Management

Jul 2-6: Organizations, People and Performance

### **Is there an attendance requirement?**

Full attendance is required and expected.

### **Can we attend part of the programme?**

Yes, you can.

Successful completion of 6 modules entitles you to a WMG Postgraduate Diploma.  
Successful completion of 3 modules entitles you to a WMG Postgraduate Certificate.  
Successful completion of individual modules can also be certified.

**When can we enrol for the programme?**

You can enrol on the programme at any time during the academic year (see calendar above).

**How are the assignments and projects marked and supervised?**

Assignments are submitted online to the module tutor. For your project you will have an appointed supervisor at EMU.

**What is the cost of the programme?**

The cost of the entire programme for 2011-2012 only is **7800 pounds**, including all modules, language support programme, and project supervision. Individual modules are priced at **690 pounds** each

**Are there scholarships?**

This fee is approximately 50% lower than the UK fees, due to the agreement between EMU and Warwick WMG. Please also bear in mind that in completing the masters programme in one year, you will make a substantial saving on living costs and accommodation, as well as moving more quickly to the next phase of your career.

**Is there any difference between the degree offered at Warwick, UK, and the degree offered at Warwick, EMU?**

No. You receive exactly the same degree, and are entitled to attend the UK graduation ceremony with all other WMG graduates.

## Warwick University WMG Masters Programme Exemptions for EMU students

EMU postgraduate students who enroll for any one week intensive modules on the Warwick University MSc programme in Supply Chain and Logistics Management, or MSc programme in Engineering Business Management, will benefit in the following ways:

- ✓ Be exempt from the WMG modules passed (continuous assessment and assignment – no examination) if they subsequently register for the full WMG programme.
